

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris then held a special meeting on Friday, April 12, 2002 at 9:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Herm Martens presided.

Council Members present: Ralph Groening, Sieg Neumann, Barry Fraese, Denis Robert, Leo Kornelsen, Stan Siemens.

Also Present was Greg Friesen of the LUD of Rosenort Committee.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the proposed situation of Westfield Industries proposal for the purchasing a portion of the old Rosenort dyke to expand their business operation.

There were many issues raised regarding this proposal and some of the greater issues included the following:

- what type and where there is to be this access to the property east of the dyke.
- the problem of Canola Drive near the dyke and the traffic problems that may be created along this road.
- what type of access Westfield would have across Canola Drive
- the drainage along PR 205 and south along the dyke would be affected by this proposal.

The general discussion was that there was no general opposition to the initial request. It was felt that the south property line of Westfield Industries should be fenced. There may be possibilities of a road connection between Canola Drive and PR 205 between Westfield Industries and Rosenort Agro.

For the area east of the dyke, it was felt that the initial area of approximately 300' south of PR 205 should be maintained for use as highway commercial.

It was felt that the water drainage along PR 205 could be rerouted to the north side of PR 205.

This portion of the meeting was then adjourned at 10:30 a.m. and Mr. Greg Friesen then left the meeting.

Council then proceeded to hold a budget meeting for the 2002 budget of the R. M. of Morris. Council reviewed the preliminary proposed budget, capital expenditures, 5 year capital program, and it was then generally accepted by Council and it was decided to hold our public meeting on May 8, 2002 at 9:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

This portion of the meeting was then adjourned at approximately 12:00 noon.
