PAYMENTS FOR TAX SALE Council decided that if any individuals want to make payments on property eligible for tax sale, that the first payment must be made before March 1, 2004, there can only be a maximum of six equal payments, and all payments must be made at least monthly by post-dated cheque. If any of these conditions are not met, the property will immediately be put up for tax sale with a \$500.00 fee per parcel.

The CAO was instructed to invite a certain resident to the March Council meeting. The CAO was also instructed to talk to the Department of Highways regarding roads and ditches in Aubigny along Provincial Roads. The CAO was further instructed to draft a letter to the Department of Fisheries and Oceans. Councillor Fraese and Councillor Groening are prepared to help with this letter. This letter should advise that they should be more pro-active in co-operation with municipalities. CAO was also instructed to set up a meeting with Mr. Dave Shwaluk during the Municipal Officials conference. The CAO was also instructed to write a letter to all possible water hook-ups for 2004 asking for a \$500.00 deposit on a total \$8000.00 cost. This would also be with a potential debenture for \$6500.00.

The R.M. of Morris is not planning any development on the Sperling schoolyard. The Council will however try to sell any vacant municipally owned property.

Councillor Groening reported that there was not much information on drainage at the G.I.S. conference. If Peter Williams or Datalink does not come up with anything new, then the R.M. may have to look elsewhere.
