Minutes of a meeting of the Council of the R.M. of Morris held on Thursday April 15, 2004 commencing at 9:00 a.m. Reeve Martens and Councillors Groening, Fraese, Kornelsen, Neumann, Robert, and Wiens were present with Reeve Martens in the chair.

Meeting With Dave Sexton Mr. Dave Sexton attended the meeting at 9:00 a.m. He advised that he was the engineer in this area for many years. He was also the Provincial director before Steve Topping, and is now retired, but gets called back periodically. He discussed the dyke program with the Council of the R.M. of Morris. He also discussed the surplus lands and the difficulty of obtaining surveys because of cost.

The Acting CAO was instructed to contact the Provincial Assessment Branch and ask them to do an assessment split. The Acting CAO was also instructed to send the Mark Delorme tax notice to Land Management Services.

The Council reviewed their Committee reports for the previous month. Councillor Groening reported that the RCMP musical ride and Ray St. Germain will be present at the Big M Stampede.

The CAO was instructed to remove the new arena from the agenda.

The CAO was also instructed to give the Building Inspector a letter regarding straw cover on lagoons. The Compliance Officer was also to be invited to the May Council meeting.

Councillor Neumann was unable to attend the afternoon session.

Councillor Groening reported that there are 80 customers who want to be hooked up for 2004. Councillor Groening also gave Council a run down of the estimated costs, and the number of hook-ups for each of the last five years. These showed a net surplus of between \$200,000.00-\$250,000.00.

Council of the R.M. of Morris decided that the responsibility of the dogcatcher would be transferred from the Livestock Committee to the Protection Committee. There will also be no more Weed District listing on the agenda.

Discussion On 2004 Water hook-Ups

Council of the R.M. of Morris reviewed a tentative agenda for the meeting with Mr. Steve Ashton on April 26, 2004. This agenda will include the Anderson drain which needs to have little cleaned out, the 4N drain which needs to be improved, the final cost of the dykes, more money for rural water lines for 2005 and Conservation Districts.

Councillor Groening suggested that it was time to meet with the Pembina Valley Water Corporation. The CAO was instructed to invite them to attend at the R.M. of Morris Council Chambers between April 27, and April 29, 2004. This meeting would be between Councillor Groening, Reeve Martens and the Public Works Foreman.

Tenders for Weed spray R.M. only

Stan Siemens attended meeting Mr. Don Harder, the Public Works Foreman, attended the meeting at 3:00 p.m. Council instructed him that the tenders for weed spraying chemicals were to be issued in the R.M. of Morris only. Mr. Stan Siemens attended the meeting at 3:15 p.m. He advised Council that he realized that the budget had already been approved, but he still wanted to give them his comments. Mr. Siemens questions the convention expense and presented an analysis for the cost per capita for various CCD's. Mr. Siemens estimated that the per capita cost for the Morris CCD was \$166.00 per person.

The CAO was instructed to arrange a meeting of the residents in the Morris CCD with the intention of setting up a Morris CCD Committee.
