Councillor Groening reported that only two persons had actually paid for the original paving in Lowe Farm.

Councillor Wiens reported on the progress with the newsletter. He needs greetings from the Reeve, and the update from the Equipment Committee and the water plan. Councillor Wiens would also like a brief budget report in this newsletter.
