## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

Minutes of a special meeting of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held on Friday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2005 commencing at 1:30 p.m. Reeve Martens and Councillors Groening, Fraese, Kornelsen, Neumann and Wiens were present with Reeve Martens in the chair. Councillor Robert had sent his apologies. The Public Works Foreman, Mr. Don Harder, was also present.

Council spent a considerable amount of time discussing the required elevations for buildings within the Rosenort Industrial Park.

140/05 Leo Kornelsen-Barry Fraese

Resolved that the R.M. of Morris set the minimum elevation for buildings within the Rosenort Industrial Park at 238.6215 meters above sea level.

141/05 Ralph Groening-Sieg Neumann

Resolved that the R.M. of Morris approve application for subdivision # 4152-05-4827 on the condition that the frontage road be adjacent to PR 205 with the turns at both ends to be 50 meters from PR 205.

Council decided to set the rate for the rental of the Council Chambers at \$100.00.

Councillor Groening reported on the proposed agreement with the Town for water hookup for Mr. James Mitchell. Council was not happy with some of the clauses and agreed to discuss it further at the June regular meeting. The CAO was asked to make the following changes: Eliminate clause B under the Town obligations and eliminate clause C under the Municipal obligations. The R.M. of Morris is prepared to assume responsibility for whatever they install.

Mr. Don Harder presented Council with the landfill rates for the R.M. of Dufferin. The Rosenort landfill has been opened twice in the evenings and not one customer has shown up. In the future the Rosenort landfill will only be opened on Wednesday evenings.

The CAO was asked to check for any by-laws that the R.M. has regarding unsightly premises.

The Public Works Foreman continued his report and advised that 22 hook-ups have been done out of 113. In Lowe Farm, they have got one block done.

Councillor Groening reported that Dr. Albert Friesen, who is an R.M. of Morris ratepayer, has received the order of Manitoba.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 4:30 p.m.
