Resolved that the R.M. of Morris agree to sell Lot 4 and the South ½ of Lot 6. Plan 11498 to Ben and Deanna Waldner for \$501.00; provided they commence building within 1 year with Lot 6 being transferred when the R.M. receives title.

The CAO was asked to send a letter to the Provincial Building Inspector regarding Midland in Rosenort and advise it does not meet R.M. of Morris requirements. A copy of this letter should be sent to the Minister questioning the allowance of an industrial building in a commercial zone.

Resolved that Reeve and CAO be authorized to sign the agreement with Manitoba Transportation.

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175/06 Ralph Groening – Leo Kornelsen

Whereas municipalities in the Red River Region are concerned that the upgrades on the PTH #75 do not address the need to keep PTH #75 open from Winnipeg to the USA border during times of high water (as in 2006);

And whereas commercial entities and municipalities in the Red River Region suffer great economic losses when the main traffic artery to the USA is closed due to high waters;

And whereas a meeting held on September 6th, 2006 addressed the need to form a coalition group to lobby the Federal and Provincial Governments to raise PTH #75, sufficiently to keep the traffic flowing through PTH #75 during high water years. To have this work prioritized as the next phase of upgrades on PTH #75;

Now therefore be it resolved that the **R.M. of Morris** appoint two members to a "Highway 75 Coalition" board for the purpose of lobbying the Federal and Provincial Governments to move quickly to flood proof this important international trade route.

176/06 Leo Kornelsen – Sieg Neumann Resolved that the R.M. of Morris approve application #4152-06-4980 with no conditions.

Reeve Martens and Deputy Reeve Groening were appointed to the PTH 75 Upgrading Committee.
177/06 Leo Kornelsen – Denis Robert Resolved that the Reeve and the CAO authorized to sign the agreement with Transport Canada.

There was considerable discussion concerning the use of an airway system manure application system. The CAO was asked to keep the pictures that had been presented to Council on September 13 th , 2006. Council is of the opinion that Feeder Barns are the worst for smell, weanlings being second and sow barns being third.
178/06 Denis Robert - Barrie Fraese Resolved that the R.M. of Morris will not authorize the use of airway manure system unless it is into grassland or crop, based on a trial in the fall of 2006.
