Resolved that the December 10th, 2008 agenda be adopted as presented and may be amended.

Lorne Hamblin attended the meeting at 9:00 a.m. He asked council to consider a curling sponsorship for a Dekalb bonspiel series. These sponsorships would range in value from \$250.00 to \$5,000.00.

Council held a hearing at 9:00 a.m. regarding zoning by-law 1636/08. No persons appeared to be heard.

She presented council with pictures of the shingles, and doors that require paint, as well as some other concerns. She also asked if the annual meeting could be better advertised.

Councillor Wiens, who is on the Lowe Farm CCD committee, responded that over the last several years the committee had been concentrating on the park in Lowe Farm. The committee believes that the park is now complete, and will be turning their attention to the hall in 2009.

Neil Schellenberg attended the meeting at 10:15 a.m. He advised council that he has several concerns regarding buildings in his development. Mr. Schellenberg is advising people at what level they have to build and they are ending up installing windows that are too low on the river side. Mr. Schellenberg asked if the RM of Morris would consider drawing up a standard waiver that people could sign so that they would assume full responsibility for their own houses. Reeve Martens replied that that the RM of Morris would rather have people building at the proper level, than granting waivers. Mr. Schellenberg also spoke regarding street maintenance in his subdivision and asked if the council could fill some low areas that have standing water. Mr. Schellenberg is planning to have curb and gutter installed in 2010. He has 12 lots left to sell,out of a total of 26.

Mr. Justin Phillips and Alex Stuart attended the meeting at 1:15 p.m. They provided council quotations for a total of three 1.2 kilowatt wind towers to be installed on top of the Public Works Garage. They estimated that this would save about 6000 kilowatt hours of electricity. The total fees for these three towers are \$45,000.00, and they were anticipating receipt of a \$25,000.00 grant. This would leave a net cost of \$20,000.00, which after recording the savings from MB Hydro over a 25 year period would leave a net cost of \$9,000.00. They explained that this would be a net cost of approximately \$340.00 per year assuming MB Hydro rates never went up.
