PRECAUTIONARY MAINTENANCE BOIL WATER ADVISORY

The RM is doing a scheduled maintenance (water shut off) on the water line at the old Rosenort Fire Hall.

Location: Old Rosenort Fire Hall (27 Main St. E.)

Date and Time: Tuesday November 13th, 2018 from approximately 10am – 2pm

The area affected is all of the Rosenort residents north of PR #205 on River Road north, Kroeker Street, Loewen, Willow, Maple and Birch.

This interruption to the water supply will lead to loss of water pressure in the distribution system for your area. Distribution system depressurization can compromise the safety of the water supply. **All water users are asked to follow boil water advisory precautions below once water service has been restored.**

To avoid purchasing bottles water, and prior to the service interruption, water users can store tap water in clean containers for drinking water purposes and should fill the bathtub for flushing water during the outage.

Once water service resumes the Utilities Department will be flushing and testing the water. Water users may experience a sputtering water flow, discoloured or dirty water after the water service is restored. This is normal and should resolve after a few minutes of running your cold water tap.

All water should be brought to a rolling boil for at least one minute before it is used for:

- **Drinking and ice making**
- **Preparing beverages, such as infant formula**
- **Preparing food**
- **Brushing teeth**

It is not necessary to boil tap water used for other household purposes, such as laundry or washing dishes. Adult and older children that are able to avoid swallowing the water can wash, bathe, or shower. Young children should be sponge bathed. If boiling is not feasible, an alternate and safe supply of water should be used.

To avoid burn injuries from hot water, cautions should be taken. Please keep young children away from boiled water, and place kettles and pots away from counters and stove edges.

Results are expected to be in 24 hours after the interruption. Once results are in we will post them to our media. You may also call our office at 204-746-7300 24 hours after the interruption.
