Utilities:

Employees will not be going in houses to do repairs of meters that cannot be read. Will
only be going in for emergency repairs or new meter installs.

Flood Preparedness Funding:

- · Ordered signs/barricades/delineators on March 24th and should have them by mid-April
- Ordered a Thompson steamer on March 24th, arriving the week of April 27th
- Ordered a gooseneck trailer on March 30th
- Order pumps and hoses March 30th and received all March 31st
- Ordered generators
- Working on road closure gates. Most of the steel was ordered beginning of March

Additions:

- · Gates will be ready for installation in the summer
- Currently are in short supply of temporary barricades
- Two areas on the River Road South walking path need to be repaired
- The mobile signs to promote the Rosenort Industrial Park are ready. Next step is for a design for advertising. Will be looking for the most cost effective option
- Currently looking at replacing the excavator. Waiting on a price to buy outright and not lease. Further discussion will take place at the budget meeting
